Submission of undertaking:

At the time of admission, students were instructed to submit an undertaking regarding anti-ragging in compliance with UGC regulations in order to ensure a ragging free campus.

Awareness Campaigns:

Sree Narayana College, Nattika conducted regular awareness campaigns to educate students and faculty about the consequences of ragging. These campaigns emphasize the importance of fostering a culture of respect and dignity among students.

Posters providing awareness on anti-ragging were displayed in prominent places of our college like front office, library, canteen etc. Contact number of college anti-ragging coordinator and National Anti-ragging helpline number were clearly mentioned in these posters.

IQAC and Anti Ragging Committee of Sree Narayana College, Nattika organized 'An Awareness programme on Anti ragging' on 14 August 2023, 2.00 pm at seminar hall. Invited Speaker Adv.T.V.Raju, Senior Advocate & Member of Juvenile Justice Board, Kerala delivered a talk on 'Anti ragging'. The session covered the rights of students, consequences of ragging and punishments mentioning relevant acts and rules. Seminar also included a discussion on anti-ragging policies, reporting mechanisms, and support services available to students. The session was very informative as the speaker shared various personal experiences that he had, during his service period. These programs aim to empower newcomers to recognize and resist instances of ragging.

Counselling and Support Services:

Our college has a counselling centre with trained counsellors, with an aim to provide emotional and psychological support to the needy students.

Monitoring and Enforcement:

Anti-ragging committee comprising faculty members, administrative staff, and student representatives monitor campus activities and enforce disciplinary measures against perpetrators. Random inspection at hostels, canteen and rest room were made to ensure the safety of students and ensured a ragging free campus.

Installed CCTV cameras at prominent places of campus, to monitor students.

By implementing comprehensive policies, raising awareness, providing support services, and enforcing disciplinary actions, in this academic year 2023-2024, Sree Narayana College, Nattika successfully and effectively prevented incidents of ragging and ensured the well-being and dignity of all students.





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
