Four Year Under Graduate Programme

Activity Report for the Academic Year 2024-25

The higher education reform of National Education Policy (NEP) primarily focuses on implementing the Four Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) across colleges and universities in India, effective this year. The FYUGP, formulated after studying recommendations of various commission reports appointed by the Higher Education Department, aims to bring about changes in teaching, learning, and evaluation methods. The new scheme was implemented from the 2024-2025 academic year, with freshly created courses which commenced in Kerala on July 1, 2024. The four-year degree program, which basically is a student oriented approach, emphasises the integration of aptitude development, career-oriented skills, and practical knowledge alongside theoretical learning in the classroom. The programme offers flexibility for students in choosing and studying different minor courses.

The Academic Monitoring Committee in association with IQAC has organised a panel discussion & open forum on Regulations For Calicut University FYUGP 2024 on 29th February 2024 @1.30 p.m in College Seminar Hall with an aim to deeply understand FYUGP regulations and to clarify the ambiguities & uncertainties regarding regulations & have a clear understanding of its implications and implementations. The panelists comprised of teaching faculties of our college, members of Board of studies members of our college. The session was a useful session for all the participants





4. A meeting of FYUGP committee members were conducted on 26th July 2024 and the agenda of the meeting was to discuss in detail the Time Table framed for Academic Year for FYUGP Students and finalisation of minor & MDC courses. 1.The final list of courses to be offered for First Semester FYUGP by our college includes 8 Major courses, 17 Minor courses, 11 MDC Courses and 13 AEC Courses were approved by FYUGP Committee.2. The committee also decided to increase the college working hours to 6 hrs (9.30 a.m to 12.30 p.m and 1.15 p.m to 3.15 p.m) as per the new regulation. 3. The Committee also decided to complete the registration process of First semester courses on 19th september 2024.
5. A meeting of FYUGP committee members were conducted on 30th september 2024 and the agenda of the meeting was to 1. review the conduct of Major,Minor and MDC classes 2. Fixing the date for internal exams, and 3.discussion about First semester University exams on November 11 2024. The committee discussed in detail the portion completion status of all courses. The committee decided to start internal exams for First Semester

FYUGP on 28th October 2024. The committee also reviewed the registration process of first semester and ensured that all courses were registered correctly and on time.

6. A meeting of FYUGP committee members were conducted on 17th september 2024 and the agenda of the meeting was 1. Conduct of Internal Exam 2. Discussion on Internal Mark Split up. The committee decided to commence the first semester internal exam on 28th October 2024. The exams were decided to conduct in two sessions a day. Discussion on Internal mark Split up was done and soft copy of the same was mailed to all departments.
7. A meeting of FYUGP committee members were conducted on 24th October 2024 and the agenda of the meeting was to reschedule The First Semester Internal Exams as the University exams postponed to 26th November 2024. It was decided to conduct internal exams from November 1st to 6 and practical exams from on October 30 & November 8 2024.
8. A meeting of FYUGP committee with all the teachers were conducted on 8th November 2024 and the agenda of the meeting was with regard to Evaluation of answer scripts of Internal exams. Detailed discussion on evaluating answer scripts was done and also decided to conduct class PTA by 13th November 2024. Remedial classes were need to be conducted and should prepare students to write well the upcoming University exams was also decided.
9. A meeting of FYUGP committee with all the teachers were conducted on 28th November 2024. The agenda of the meeting were 1. Commencement of Second Semester FYUGP Classes, 2. Selection of Minor & MDC Courses, 3. Feedback collection about FUYUGP. The committee decided to commence second semester classes on December 10th 2024. In second semester the college decided to offer 8 Major courses, 17 minor courses, 12 MDC Courses and 13 AEC Courses. For familiarising the students about the courses, all department planned to do Power point presentation about the courses they offered. A feedback about FYUGP was prepared by Academic Monitoring Committee and was circulated among students. The committee also decided to encourage students to do online courses in SWAYAM plartform.
10. A meeting of FYUGP committee with all the teachers were conducted on 7th March 2025. The agenda of the meeting were 1. Conduct of second semester Internal exams. 2. Selestion of Minor & MDC courses for the Third semester. 3. Courses to be offered in the first semester for FYUGP 2025 -2029 Batch and 4. Internship of FYUGP 2024 -28 Batch. The committee decided second semester internal exams from 17th march to 20th march and pratical exams on 21,24 & 25 March 2025. All department were directed to prepare question papers before 14th March 2025 . Department were also directed to upload the second semester APC before 13th March 2025. All language department were directed to plan the MDC they wish to offer in Third semester and convey the same before 14th March 2025. The departments were instructed to take the initiatives for doing the internship in the summer vacation after the end of University exams. The camp chairman

of first semester were directed to handover the answer scripts of first semester to camp director before 20th March 2025. The students who wish to switch their Majors were directed to communicate the same to their concerned FYUGP Department coordinators and class Tutors.
