## 12. Election Quest: The Board Came – Election Awareness Game

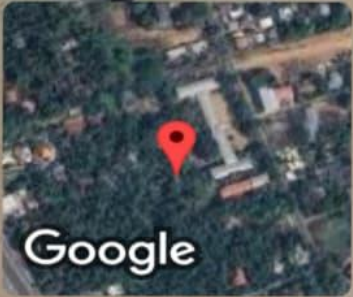

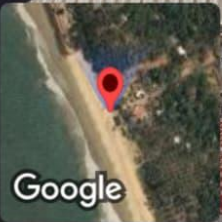
